CURRICULAR INNOVATIONS

Throughout my role as the founding Director of the Music Business and Entrepreneurship program (bachelor's, master's, and doctoral) at the University of Florida, I have been dedicated to developing curricular innovations that have shaped the educational landscape in this field. I founded the very first music business curriculum at the university, spanning undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate levels, catering to music majors and non-music majors from various disciplines. One of my notable achievements has been the cross-listing of courses, allowing students from different programs and levels of study to benefit from the comprehensive music business and entrepreneurship curriculum. This interdisciplinary approach fosters a diverse learning environment and encourages collaboration among students with varied backgrounds and interests. To enhance the educational experience, I created a set of instructional videos that accompany the music business and entrepreneurship curricula. These videos provide additional resources for students to grasp complex concepts, understand real-world scenarios, and develop practical skills.

Recognizing the importance of industry exposure and networking, I actively invited and facilitated the participation of 60+ guest speakers who are experts in the field of music/arts business and entrepreneurship. These professionals shared their insights, experiences, and advice with our students, inspiring them and guiding them in developing their own business plans and music productions. In Fall 2022, I introduced a doctoral-level course called "Arts Entrepreneurship Research." This course equips doctoral students, specializing in entrepreneurship, with the necessary skills to design, research, write,

and publish empirical studies and music productions within the realm of arts entrepreneurship. The outcomes of my students' projects include publications in the Journal of Arts Entrepreneurship Education, the Association for Popular Music Education's peer-reviewed blog, and the achievement of winning a 2022 Global Music® Award for a Mixed-Genre Album, among other publications and awards.

As a team member behind the University of Florida's Bachelor of Science in Music Business and Entrepreneurship degree, I played a key role in its development. Through extensive research on peer programs and Florida SUS programs, as well as an assessment of demand and growth in related fields, I collaborated closely with colleagues from the School of Music to create a comprehensive proposal for the degree and the development of new courses. This proposal, approved by the Dean and Provost, is set for review and approval by the Board of Governors. Additionally, I developed both Undergraduate and Graduate Certificates in Music Business & Entrepreneurship at the University of Florida. These certificates have received approval from the School of Music, College of the Arts, and the Graduate School, and are currently undergoing upper-division processes before being officially launched in the near future.

To provide interdisciplinary opportunities, I established a partnership with the Warrington College of Business and the Center of Entrepreneurship. This collaboration enables Doctor of Musical Arts students to take my Music Business and Entrepreneurship courses, which are now cross-listed as ENT 6XXX-level courses, counting towards their doctoral cognate in Entrepreneurship. Moreover, I have focused on experiential learning and have actively facilitated opportunities for students to gain real-world experience and recognition. By fostering partnerships with GRAMMY® Award-winning and nominated artists, students have had the privilege to co-produce, audio engineer, market, and publish their original work, resulting in accolades such as GRAMMY® and Latin GRAMMY® Nomination Ballot Considerations, Global Music® Awards, published research articles, and other awards.

To empower students with the necessary skills for success, I have guided them in developing their personal brand and professional portfolio. Each student has created high-end websites, media content, contracts, promotional and legal documents, business plans, and more. This comprehensive approach ensures that they are well-prepared for the industry and increases their marketability and employability. Furthermore, I have fostered an environment of research and collaboration, inviting select students to co-author research articles and documentaries. Their work has been accepted for publication in esteemed journals such as the Journal of Arts Entrepreneurship Education, showcasing the scholarly contributions made by our program.

Finally, I continue to organize and facilitate the UF Music Producers' Showcase, providing students with a platform to showcase their talents, network with industry professionals, and collaborate with peers. This event has become a valuable networking opportunity within the recording arts and sciences community, further enhancing the experiential learning opportunities for our students. In summary, my role at the University of Florida has been characterized by developing curricular pathways in the field of music business and entrepreneurship. From creating the first music business curriculum to spearheading the development of the Bachelor of Science in Music Business and Entrepreneurship degree, I have continually strived to provide students with a comprehensive and relevant education. I hope to shape the next generation of music business leaders and entrepreneurs through partnerships, industry exposure, experiential learning, and scholarly contributions.
